1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

a) Beyond all boundary fences and walls. on or over the entrance drive. To the right of the white posts on the 9th & 18th holes. Over the staked line around the practice putting area.

- 2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)
- a) Lateral water hazards are identified by red posts.
- b) Water hazards re-identified by yellow posts.
- 3. Bunkers

a) Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions rule 24-1 applies

4. Integral parts of the course

a) Wall in front of the green on the 11th hole is deemed as an integral part of the course (Rule 33-2) relief maybe taken under penalty of one stroke. (Rule 28)

5. Sink hole, on 10th hole, relief maybe taken without penalty (rule 24-2b)

Penalty clause. For those local rules not covered by a rule of golf. Match play - loss of hole stroke play - 2 strokes

## 6. Protective Fence

a) Relief maybe taken from the protective fence, between the 17th & 18th holes, under rule 24-2. If relief is taken, then the designated drop zone is to be used without penalty.

## 7. Protection of young trees

a) If such a tree interferes with a players stance or area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped in accordance with procedure prescribed in rule 24-2b (immovable obstruction)
