

RULES & PROCEDURES

Doncaster Culture and Leisure Trust has produced these temporary rules and procedures based on guidance from England Golf.

It is essential that the course re-opens in a responsible and safe way and that government advice and policy are adhered to at all times. Full guidance can be found at www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19

Please play safely and stay safe, considering yourself and others at all times.

COMMON PRINCIPLES

- Do not come to the Crookhill if you are unwell or a person advised to self-isolate or shield.
- Follow any signage and restrictions on the course and in the club house.
- Maintain a social distance of 2m at all times.
- Do not congregate anywhere at Crookhill at anytime.
- It is advised that all players have their own personal hand sanitiser and this should be used frequently, especially before and after play.

BOOKING A TEE TIME

Tee times are booked using the BRS Golf System and can be made 8 days in advance. One golfer can book themselves in and their playing partner. Tee times will be at 16 minute intervals and will be for two balls only.

With high demand, we would ask golfers to be considerate to each other when booking. If you can play at quieter times then please do so, to allow others who are more restricted with their time to still be able to make a booking.

CAR PARK

Golfers should park in alternate spaces where possible. Golfers should come to the course ready to play and can change shoes in the car park. The car park gate will be locked at 18:30.

GOLF BUGGIES & TROLLEYS

As the sanitisation of club buggies & trolleys cannot be policed and guaranteed and the fact they could only be used by one person, these will not be available for hire at this present time.

PLAY

- Only attend the tee at your allocated tee time. Do not congregate on the tee.
- Keep social distance (2m) from your playing partner at all times.
- Once on the green the furthest away should putt out until they have completed the hole and then the next player should do the same. It is advised for social golf that "gimmes" are used.
- If marking a card mark one card or your own.
- Leave the flag in the inverted hole and do not touch the flag.
- There will be no rakes in the bunkers. Please use the back of your club to smooth the sand. Preferred lies are available in all bunkers.
- Do not use ball washers, waste bins or use course furniture. Take any personal litter home.
- If you should catch any group in front do not attend the tee at the same time.
If you are caught by a group playing behind then please wave through immediately and do not attend any tee at the same time allowing for social distancing.
- Do not shake hands after play.
- Leave the course immediately after play.
- The Club house will remain closed
- Toilet facilities are available with a one in one out process

COMPETITION GOLF

There will be no competition golf until further notice.

PRACTICE AREAS

All practice areas are closed until further notice, including the putting green.

COURSE CONDITION

OBVIOUS ISSUES WILL BE:

- Reduced pace of greens through higher cutting heights
- Higher cutting heights in all / most maintained areas
- Lengthier rough areas, particularly in 'out of play' areas
- Untidy bunkers
- Lack of golf course furniture such as bunker rakes, bins, ball washers and benches.

To help monitor against the government's current conditions and our internal expectations, DCLT's Health and Safety team will conduct audits against social distancing and the above temporary rules, ensuring that the course is operating in a safe manner.
