This skatepark has been provided for all wheeled sports.

Supervision

This is not a children's playground. Younger users must be supervised by an adult until they understand the etiquette and how to use the space safely. If in doubt, ask an experienced user for advice.

Litter and Anti-social Behaviour

Everybody has a better time in a nicer environment. This is your space and it is up to you to look after it. Put litter in the bins and they will be emptied. Do not smoke, drink alcohol or use drugs. Look out for each another.

New Users

As long as you aren't impeding the riders, you are welcome here too, this is a public space designed for the whole community. Talk to some users, you may be surprised and whatever you think, you wouldn't be the oldest or least likely new user.

Be Welcoming

Everybody learns from somebody else, it is up to the older and more experienced users to set an example and welcome the younger and newer ones. The best start is by saying hello to every new face you see - remember everyone was a beginner once...

This space has been designed and built for the entire community. It is not owned by any one group. All users must be respectful of others regardless of age, ability, gender or discipline. Good riders will always be supportive and encouraging of all new participants. Create a positive environment for everyone to enjoy.
